

Prior to beginning hourly rounding, emergency departments must decide which tactic to implement, who will round on patients, and how to document results. Studer Group recommends using hourly rounding with individualized patient care in the reception area as well as in treatment rooms and using a 24-hour rounding log like the one below.
